Important Vendor Information

- Set up time begins at 8AM.; you will be able to drive to your tent space to unload.
- You will be directed to your space when you arrive at the grounds.
- All vehicles must be moved from the grounds by 11AM. Any vendor arriving after that time will be able to move inventory to their site by hand truck.
- Vendor parking will be in the designated FMCV parking lot free.
- Tear down begins at 6PM. Vehicles will not be allowed on the grounds before that time.
- Vendors must provide their own tents.
- Electricity is available only at certain locations at the site.
- Acceptance of any application is dependent on available space as determined by the festival committee.
- Registration fees are not refundable if participation is cancelled within two weeks of the festival date.
- Collection of and reporting of Virginia Sales Tax Is the responsibility of the Vendor.
- Vendors must comply with all Virginia and US laws and regulations.
- The festival will be held regardless of weather unless the festival committee determines that there is a danger to the public.
- Vendors are fully responsible for the protection of their property and for securing their tents and displays.
- Two wine glasses and two wristbands will be issued to each vendor with proof of age. It is the responsibility of the vendor to insure only those 21 years or older have access to these.
- Trash containers and bags will be provided by FCMV. Please be prepared to recycle glass, aluminum, plastic and cardboard as directed by the FMCV staff.
